The Office of Regulation Counsel has reviewed the evidence submitted by you in your request for investigation in light of the Colorado Rules of Procedure regarding unauthorized practice of law. The Office of Regulation Counsel has determined that the circumstances here do not warrant injunctive proceedings against Janet Aluise.

After review of your request for investigation, we conclude that conduct by Ms. Aluise does not pose a present danger to the People of the State of Colorado and does not warrant proceedings to enjoin Ms. Aluise from further unauthorized practice of law. She has closed her consulting business and does not intend to resume work as a planner.

Thank you for your willingness to bring this matter to our attention and for your cooperation. Your involvement in submitting this information regarding unauthorized practice of law is a vital part of the Colorado Supreme Court's efforts to ensure that unauthorized practice of law does not occur.
